Multi-Purpose CAA has need for contractors to complete work on eligible homes that may be weatherized through Department of Energy or LIHEAP Weatherization funding. See below for necessary information regarding becoming a contractor on our Approved Contractor List.

**Weatherization Contractors Needed:**

Multi-Purpose Community Action Agency seeks contractors to perform Energy System Repairs or Replacements and/or Weatherization work. The agency seeks general contractors as well as HVAC Licensed Contractors. Specific training certifications will be required to be on the Approved Contractor List. The following should not be considered exhaustive of requirements, but generalized, lead safe work practices, lead renovator training, lead renovator firm, CPR and First Aid certified, ASHRAE 6.2 Certified, Kentucky Housing Corporation Mold and Moisture training and proficiency with a Blower Door (BPI). Contractors will need to have \$800,000 minimum insurance coverage for General Liability. Work is awarded through a bidding process. **Quality Control Inspector Needed:**

Multi-Purpose Community Action Agency seeks a contractual Quality Control Inspector. If preferred by candidate, consideration will be made to have this person hired as an employee. The qualified candidate will have all of the above trainings & certifications (contractors will also need the insurance). If we choose to hire you as an employee the insurance will not be required. In order to be QCI certified, the candidate will have attended a training program to assist in preparation of passing the written and field certification exams. Preferably they will already be QCI certified, but candidates will be considered who are willing to obtain the necessary training. Industry certifications such as RESNET, BPI, NATE, EPA are helpful in meeting the minimum requirements to take the test as are working as an energy auditor or crew leader in various construction industries.
